Consider foot washing, ministering, deliverance, the sacrament, and intercessory prayer. Depending on any of these areas under the direction of the Holy Spirit to achieve the cleansing of the soul.

3. make me HEAR JOY. H8085 Shamá. Hear, intelligently obedience. H8342 Sasón. happiness; welcome: - joy, jubilation.

We must implement the reading of the continuous word, the meditation on it, the participation in liberation cults and the delivery of burdens. Teaching the importance of raising praise and worship.

4. HIDE H5641 Satár. to hide (covering), to hide, to cover, to cover, cover up, conceal, conceal, concealed, reserve, secret.

Knowing how to hear what they must tell us, becoming true restorers and always understanding their situation. Not condemning but restoring, letting them know that God's purpose is that every soul be saved.

5. ERASE. H4229 Maká. hit or rub; erase; also, smooth (as with oil), grease or grease; reach to... undo, destroy, wipe, exterminate, scrub, scrape, marrow.

In this phase they must stop remembering the wrong done, feel totally forgiven and beg God to minimize the consequences for his great mercy.

6. CREATE. H1254 Bara create; select, feed (as formative processes): - raise, be born

This is a new opportunity, a new beginning, knowing that we were taken by Him and the one who began a good work in us will perfect it. Thus, understanding the parable of the prodigal son.

7. RENEW.H2318 Kjadásh. being new; rebuild: - compose, rejuvenate, renew, repair, restore.

The branch shows the restoration, the fullness of blessings and the willingness to start over.

Psalm 37:4 "Delight yourself also in the Lord. And he will grant you the requests of your heart.

We will perform miracles in the name of Jesus

As you think so it will be.

GAL 3:5 He therefore who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does he do it by the works of the law or by hearing with faith?

Gen 22:17 Surely, I will bless you greatly, and I will greatly multiply your offspring as the stars in the sky and as the sand on the seashore, and your offspring shall possess the gate of their enemies.

<u>Isa 54:2</u> Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch out the curtains of your dwellings, spare not; lengthen your ropes, and strengthen your stakes.

Beware of thinking sparsely, we must widen ourselves and declare expansion time.

1. Measurable: must be able to measure or check the success in the achievement

We do not offer what we cannot fulfill. Let us be aware that we are doing God's work and we cannot be liars or arrogant, believing that by our much talk we will reach the attention of men. We must deliver reports to be able to follow up on what we have achieved.

2. Attractive: must reflect the aspirations and expectations of all the affected.

Being restored by the supernatural power of Christ is not something people don't want. It is something that they do not know, so it is difficult for them to accept that they will find what they need along this path. Therefore, our testimony must be impeccable to reach many.

3. <u>Possible: realistic and achievable objectives must be included, even when they imply</u> a challenge.

Let's not set impossible goals for ourselves, we must fulfill what we promise.

4. Strategic: must include the decisive issues to successfully fulfill the mission.

Every decision we make should be focused on being able to make what we plan to do from the beginning come true. There are many ways to reach souls. We should not use all of them, only those that we manage efficiently.

5. Understandable: it must have clarity and precision

Let's avoid getting away from the main topic. Let's be direct and insist on speaking to each person with the word of truth.

6. <u>Inspiring: that stimulates and causes a positive effect on people, inspiring others to join him/her.</u>

When we have started and others see our positive and inspiring attitude, they will want to do the same and many more will join the vision.

7. <u>Time: must establish the time in years.</u>

We must do all this in 5 years, and run, persevering towards the goal and reach the number of souls that we proposed in our hearts.

Characteristics of the Vision of God

The Vision Motivates to Run after he and who has it

PRO 4:18 But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which increases in brightness until it is broad daylight.

Gideon's life helps us understand this. Being visited by the Angel of the Lord, his life changed. Being in a condition of flight, he took the Spiritual sword of the Lord and summoned the people and chose 300 faithful men who understood and captured the feeling of the servant called by The Lord. Whenever something big is undertaken, many sign up, but only the faithful remain and finish the race to the specific goal.

1. Vision Produces Power

2SA 22:29 For you are my lamp, O Lord; The Lord enlightens my darkness. 30 For with you I will crush armies, with my God I will scale walls.

Nothing is impossible for the one who believes. We must consider in our walk as children of God, what our end will be and how we will finish the race. We cannot continue to live in lukewarmness and spiritual conformity and let our years go by thinking about our problems and not moving forward to what we most long for. Live in the Heavenly homeland. Let us consider our bodies as dead to sin and dispose them to serve God.

2. The Vision Always Leaves a Legacy

PSA 119:105 ¶ Your word is a lamp to my feet, and a light for my path.

IS 52:7 ¶ How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who announces peace, who brings glad tidings of joy, who announces salvation, and says to Zion: Your God reigns!!

Our Lord Jesus Christ left a legacy by having saved the world from eternal damnation. Taking this attitude, we must strip ourselves of everything that prevents us from making what God wants to come true. May we be life savers by spreading the gospel of salvation and making many participate in the best resurrection.

Our Vision

Isa 58:6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen: to loosen the bonds of wickedness, loosen the bands of the yoke, let the oppressed go free, and break every yoke? Rom 10:15 And how can they preach if they are not sent? As it is written: HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO ANNOUNCE THE GOSPEL OF GOOD!

Rom 10:16 However, not everyone paid attention to the gospel, because Isaiah says: LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR ANNOUNCEMENT?
Rom 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.


lead them to Christ

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1 Teas. 2:13 RV 1960 (13) For which we also give thanks to God without ceasing, that when you received the word of God that you heard from us, you received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which acts in you believers.



DISCIPLES

The disciples are the believers who have begun to love the word and the teaching. Let us always consider having the doctrinal principles rooted in our hearts to face any wind of doctrine that opposes what we teach and wants to divert from the faith those who are being formed in discipleship.

Acts 6:7 And the word of God increased, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and many of the priests obeyed the faith.



SERVANTS

The servants are those disciples who, previously trained in the word, serve with joy and love within the work. Not out of responsibility but out of love, principles of authority and subjection that will lead them to grow in the gospel and to perform their task better every day.

Mar 13:34 RV 1960 It is like the man who, going far, left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to each one his work, and commanded the gatekeeper to watch.

Knowers of Mysteries

FRIENDS

Friends are trustworthy and are all those who through their fidelity and dedication have become people of high esteem before the Lord.

John 15:15 RV 1960 I will no longer call you servants, because the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, because all the things that I heard from my father, I have made known to you.

I wish to emphasize the importance of each of the points addressed and the activities necessary to make them a reality. For this reason, I divide it into three large groups and the fourth is our conquest in Canaan.

Leaving Egypt arriving to the desert From Jordan to Canaan Canaan from listeners to believers from believers to disciples from disciples to servants from servants to friends

Start of the Mission

When I received the call from God and was sent to the city where I currently pastor, I asked him to reveal to me that I should do, he immediately showed me a large network and I understood that my purpose was to extend the network to the entire area that encompassed different cities of the entrusted territory.

Now with years in this ministry I see the first part of everything I received from the Lord that afternoon. And he has shown me by various signs that the time has come to fulfill the other part that is missing, to take the net out of the water full of fish. I have determined that over time 7 essential tasks have been carried out so that all this could happen. Now that the net has deepened, it is time for all the fishermen to take out the net and choose the fish on the shores.

I asked the Lord about the Mission Entrusted verse and He showed me these verses. I have tried all this time to follow these established principles and I have realized the fruit that God has allowed. Now once again in debt to the Lord and not forgetting to apologize for the mistakes made, I get ready for the next task and seeing who wants to follow me to undertake this new challenge.

1Pe 5:2 shepherd the flock of God among you, watching over it, not under compulsion, but voluntarily, as God wants; not out of greed for money, but with sincere desire.

1Pe 5:3 Nor as having dominion over those entrusted to you but proving to be examples to the flock.

During the exercise of the pastoral ministry, I have realized that there are people with many talents, I can almost certainly say that I have not seen anyone who own nothing. Everyone has qualities and characteristics that, when developed in the service of God, can make a great difference in the expansion of the work.

He is interested in filling us with virtues, some of which we do not know we have, but for that there are people who activate them for us and that is why they become evident at the time.

When Saul went to the seer's house, his arrival was due to some lost donkeys, their meeting was something prophetic that changed his life forever. God revealed his purpose through the mouth of the prophet Samuel and all the rest is history.

Now it's up to us to discover what God's purpose is for your life and surely, he will reveal it in due time. Let us not be like the prophet Jeremiah or like Moses, who said: I DON'T KNOW HOW TO SPEAK AND I'M CLUMP OF LANGUAGE. For God, the limitations or complexes of man are broken, and they do not have any kind of power.

Now I will show you seven steps that we are going to take towards excellence in the Lord. Remember the moment you say I can't, Philippians 4.13 says otherwise.

ENERGY

No one should do anything in their own strength. The Lord said you will receive power from on high. At Pentecost there was the infilling of the Holy Spirit. We must cry out for that fullness to receive spiritual energy. No tired, intimidated, diffident can be enlisted in these ranks if he has not previously received power.

Isa 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and power to the helpless. Isa 40:31 But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will grow wings like eagles; they will run without getting tired, they will walk without getting tired.

Let us cry out for the fullness of the Holy Spirit to come upon us, as part of this equipment we must have a first retreat called, "In search of God and his power".

IN SEARCH FROM GOD AND HIS POWER

1Ti 4:7 "There are those who go around inventing silly stories that are not from God. Dedicate all your energies to exercising yourself in devotion, 4:8 because, just as physical exercise (even if it is of limited use) is beneficial for the body, spiritual exercise is useful for everything, since it contains the promise of life, both current and future.

Every day it becomes more necessary to take advantage of time. How much time do you really dedicate to God? In prayer in reading his word in meditation or sharing with your family? Devotion will take us to another level of understanding and action.

There are things that take away our energy here some of them:

SELF-SUFFICIENCY

Deu. 8:17 All of this was done so that you would never think, "I have achieved all this wealth with my own strength and energy."

Never think that what you have achieved is due to your effort, give glory to God in all the acts of your life and be grateful. Do not trust in your own prudence, take refuge in the Lord and in the power of his strength. All things will be possible if you add a dose of faith.

OTHER CULTURES

Hos 7:9 Foreigners consume your energies without your realizing it. His head is strewn with gray hair, and he doesn't notice it.

The culture of the place where you are, or the customs should not be an obstacle for someone filled with the power of the Holy Spirit. We will be doers of the word. And we must not conform to the current of this century.

WOMEN:

Pro-31:3 Do not waste your energies with women, nor your ways in overthrowing kings.

Let's not waste time on pleasures and sins that all they do is weaken our energy and lose our strength. Take the example of Samson who, even though he was anointed and predestined from his mother's womb, lost part of his life because of his sexual weakness.

SUFFERINGS:

Pro 12:25 A deep sorrow weakens the energies; good news returns joy.

Big problems discourage us and take away our strength. Our full trust is in the Lord. I have found that most problems do not come to take their full force in those of us who have faith. Instead, they dissipate, and we see the hand of God operating powerfully to the point that they fall apart before our eyes. For the glory of God.

PERVERSE MOUTH:

Pro-15:4 The words that appease are a tree of life; the perverse tongue breaks the energies.

Let's associate with people who have a spiritual speech and not with gossips, negative or gossips that all they do is stop the camp with their talk that is useless. Let us fulfill the wish of Our Lord and even if they vituperate us, let us continue forward.

OLD SPIRIT:

Josh. 14:11 And I still have the same strength that I had on the day Moses sent me. For the battle I have the same energies that I had then.

It's never too late to start. If we all unite as one man, we will know that we can collaborate in God's work and not remain idle. Let us always seek to be useful and never enter the sphere of "I CAN'T".

BEGIN

The revelation of God's purpose in our lives is going to happen through prophetic contact. In these meetings we must ask the Spirit of Prophecy to activate us and that our words touch the heart of the person. In part we will speak and in part we will prophesy. We will bring the precise words to touch hearts and speak on behalf of God and not of us.

1Sa 10:6 Then the Spirit of the Lord will come upon you with great power and a change will take place in you. You will be a different person (A NEW MAN) and you will begin to prophesy like them.

1Sa 10:7 Then you can do what you want because God will be with you.

In addition to this power, let us always consider having our own domain, because it will give us the balance and maturity, we need to realize the vision.

Our beginning may be meaningless, but our end must be glorious. Within these two facets there is an essence: spiritual training!

JER 18:4 And the clay pot that he was making was ruined in the potter's hand; so, he made another pot of it again, as it seemed best to the potter to make it.

We must work with love and patience, just as the potter does, understanding that within all this, the restoration of the soul will take place. Let us consider how much patience the Lord has given us, how many years have been invested in us, how many sermons we have received, how many powerful impartations and cults. For all this, let us ask the Father of spirits to send a SPIRIT OF MEEKNESS over us and upon receiving it, let us define our walk in the Lord as Ruth did. Let nothing and no one separate us from the path that God has marked for our lives. We will go to the House of Pan (Belem), and we will take with us all bitter, mourning, without hope and we will be blessed by his word.

RUTH 1:16 But Ruth said:

- 1. Don't insist that he leave you or stop following you.
- 2. because where you go, I will go,
- 3. and where you dwell, I will dwell.
- 4. Your people will be my people,
- 5. and your God my God.

- 8. So do the Lord with me, and even worse, if something, except death, separates us.

RUTH 1:19 ¶ So they both walked until they came to Bethlehem. And it happened that when they arrived at Bethlehem, the whole city was moved because of them, and the women said: Is not this Naomi?

We will return to our heavenly homeland, and we will be filled with his presence.

ELABORATE

God has given us the Spirit of love, power, and self-control. These three words contain the key to enter his work (DEVELOP). We must never say that we are useless. On the contrary, we declare what we are good for and what we are useful for. Once we begin to declare, the Lord takes care of filling us and training us for his work. To reach souls we have developed this strategy, asking the Lord for direction, and considering several of the themes that we have shared throughout this ministry.

We will do an activity to understand the talent we have and that we can help in the evangelization plan SCOPE 20-25.

EXO 31:2 Behold, I have called by name Bezaleel, the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah.

EXO 31:3 And I have filled him with the Spirit of God in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in every kind of art, EXO 31:4 to make designs, to work in gold, silver, and bronze, EXO 31:5 and in the carving of stones for setting, and in the carving of wood; to work in all kinds of work.

The important thing in Bezaleel's life was to carry out the design and manufacture of the most holy things. The departments where art and manufacturing are involved are important for the realization of this project.

EXO 30:37 And the incense that you shall make, you shall not make in the same proportions for your own use; it will be holy to the Lord.

Our goal is to raise a perfume of adoration and present our bodies as a sacrifice pleasing to the Lord.

We will do another activity AFTERNOON WORSHIP.

ENTRUST

Many will follow us, the called, the chosen are few and among them we will see the manifestation of the faithful. We cannot entrust something of the Lord to someone who is unfaithful. We will all have the opportunity to serve, but only a few will do what pleases God. Whenever there is an encomienda there must be fidelity. With faithful people, the path will be traveled, and the goal achieved.

- 1Ti 1:18 This commission I entrust to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies that were made before about you, so that you may fight the good fight for them,
 - 1Ti 1:19 keeping the faith and a good conscience, which some have rejected and shipwrecked as regards faith.

In a mission from God, the battle is imminent, and we must be strong. Here we will see the true warriors of God. Those who resist the test and those who overcome it and win.

1Thes 2:4 Rather, as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak; not as those who seek to please men, but as God who examines our hearts.

Present yourself as a worker of God, approved that you do not have to be ashamed. Let us announce his salvation and let us propose to be like Noah, a preacher of justice.

Only God will really know our diligence or negligence.

Mat 24:45 Which of you is the faithful and wise servant to whom the master entrusts the task of dividing the food on time among the other fellow servants?

Distributing food is sharing his word with as many as we can and bringing them to the need to congregate and disciple themselves in what we will call houses of salvation.

Luk 20:11 And another emissary was added to the encomienda, but they, also this one, having beaten and insulted him, sent him away empty-handed.

Let us remember that there are evil people who do not want to hear anything from God, let us not enter vain arguments with them. We must always be prepared with doctrine, to refute any argument that is presented and battle against those who sow unbelief. Strong battles for faith will be fought here.

2Ti 2:2 And of those whom you have heard of me among many witnesses, commend the same to other loval men, who will be able to teach others.

Advance leaving seed imparting what you know to others so that it becomes viral, and in a short time many will be in the same feeling.

STIMULUS

Destructive criticism, bad comments, inappropriate demands, shouting to give orders, harm the hearts of those who want to do the work with love. We must behave as true children of God and fill ourselves with his love to speak with prudence, rectitude, exhortation, encouragement, and positivism. This will cause people to be STIMULATED to do God's work.

HEB 10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds

GOD DOES NOT LIE AND ALWAYS KEEPS WHAT HE PROMISES. This is called the Anchor of the gospel and it leads us to the understanding and conviction that we are not helpless. That always, even amid failures, victory has already occurred on the cross of Calvary and that is why we must be safe in everything we do for Him.

Heb 6:17 Therefore, when God wanted to ensure that he would keep his promise, he swore that he would give what he promised without changing anything.

Heb 6:18 Now since God does not lie; his promise and his oath cannot change. This comforts us, because we want God to protect us, and we trust that he will give us what he promised.

We cannot be fighting the good fight in sin; we must get rid of everything that contaminates us and takes away our strength and advance in the knowledge of God.

2Kings 5:1 And Naaman, captain of the army of the king of Aram, was a great man in the sight of his lord and held in high esteem, because through him the Lord had given victory to Aram. The man, too, was a valiant warrior, but a leper.

It is necessary to go to the Jordan (spiritual) and wash ourselves 7 times (seeking humiliation) so that our SELF surrenders and HE is established in our hearts.

Our purpose is to become messengers of his word.

- PHI 2:25 But I thought it necessary to send you Epaphroditus, my brother, collaborator, and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger and servant for my needs.
 - PHI 2:29 Receive him therefore in the Lord with all joy, and esteem such as him highly.
- PHI 2:30 because he was on the verge of death for the work of Christ, risking his life to complete what was missing in your service to me.

Despite his suffering, Epaphroditus continued to persevere, doing the work. We must have that internal fire that leads us to be emissaries, Ambassadors of God.

1 TH 5:12 But we beseech you, brethren, to recognize those who labor diligently among you, and guide you in the Lord and instruct you,

1 TH 5:13 and that you esteem them very highly with love, because of their work. Live in peace with each other.

We will become of high esteem for those who have been reached. We will receive many blessings on this earth and later in the heavenly homeland.

1 TH 5:14 And we exhort you, brethren, to admonish the undisciplined, encourage the discouraged, support the weak, and be patient with all.

Our attitude must be straight to have authority and form in love those who are not doing well. Lead them to a change of attitude and dedication to the Lord.

Pro-22:1 Of more esteem is a good name than great riches, And a good name more than silver and gold.

Let us seek to be blameless in the Lord, so that no one has anything to say about us and if they say so, blessed are we because they treated the Lord Jesus Christ that way.

PUSH

It is not about pushing people with our hands. That was what they wrongly did to Alexander. When we talk about push, we are talking about causing an outbreak in people, something that gives them hope to continue or to start. An outbreak that leads them to dream of the impossible. An outbreak that leads to fruiting and kicks them out of sterility. A sprout, a vision, a mission in this world that is ending before our eyes. Imprint THE NAME OF JESUS on people. Bring seed, flow in the river of the Spirit of healing and blessing that covers every need.

ACT 19:33 And some of the crowd deduced that it was Alexander, since the Jews had pushed him forward. Then Alejandro, making a sign of silence with his hand, wanted to make his defense before the assembly.

Become sources of living waters and be activated to attend to the spiritual, sentimental, and corporal need.

JOH 4:14 But whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never thirst, but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

Water the land and prepare it to implant the seed of life and that it bears much fruit.

Mar 4:8 But another part fell on good ground, and bore fruit, for it sprouted and grew, and produced thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold.

Sowers of his word, in our house, in our city, in our country and to the rest of the world.

MAR 4:26 ¶ He also said: The kingdom of God is like a man who sows seed on the ground,

MAR 4:27 and lies down and rises, night and day, and the seed sprouts and grows; how, he doesn't know.

MAR 4:28 The earth produces fruit by itself, first the leaf, then the spike, and then the ripe grain on the spike.

MAR 4:29 And when the fruit allows it, he immediately puts in the sickle, because the harvest time has come.

Our harvest will be bountiful, our barns will be filled, and we will sow without measure with all that we have and can. We will finish our race in great victory.

HEB 9:4 which had the golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant overlaid with gold, in which was a golden urn containing the manna and Aaron's rod that budded and the tables of the covenant.

We will take the presence of God to the ends of the earth.

MAT 13:26 When the wheat sprouted and produced grain, then the tares also appeared.

We must be careful that tares do not spring up and that a little leaven does not spoil everything. We must remove from our lives all negative comments and all words that do not come to edify us. Let us be Spiritual and not carnal.

Mat 24:32 From the fig tree learn the parable: When its branch is already tender, and the leaves sprout, you know that summer is near.

Summer is harvest time and let's not be like that fig tree that asked for fruit and could not give. On the contrary that our loved one rejoices in the fruit that we give him.

JAMES 3:11 Does a spring through the same opening pour out sweet and bitter water?

Driving away all bitterness and leading us to holiness without which no one will see the Lord.

JAMES 3:12 Can a fig tree produce olives, my brethren, or a vine fig? Neither can the saltwater source produce fresh water.

We cannot go in two directions, nor stay by the side of the road. We must get involved and be defined in what we want and where we are going to go.

Let us consider that not everyone we will talk to will bear the expected fruit, however, that should not be the reason to discourage us. On the contrary, we must not stop sowing, always understanding the parable of the Sower and expecting sprouts where we least expect.

LUK 8:6 Another part fell on the rock, and as soon as it grew, it dried up, because it had no moisture.

MAT 13:5 Another part fell on stony places where it did not have much soil; and immediately it sprouted because it had no depth of earth.

Let's uproot all bitterness and consider the brother of the prodigal son, who even being at home, lived bitter and had no contentment in the father's house. Now we enjoy what God has allowed for our lives and live full of joy, hoping that the lost repent and reach their blessings.

HEB 12:15 Take heed that no man falls short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness, springing up, cause difficulties and by it many are polluted.

Let us appreciate being considered for this privilege and let us think that Esau had his opportunity, but he despised it. Now let us ask the Lord for mercy for the great opportunities that he has given us, and we may not have appreciated.

HEB 12:16 that there is no immoral or profane person like Esau, who sold his birthright for a meal. HEB 12:17 For you know that even later, when he wanted to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no occasion for repentance, although he sought it with tears.

Let us declare a time of Restitution and mercy for our lives and may He have mercy on us for everything lost and give us the opportunity to recover it.

EXECUTE

Many times, I have gone to listen to classical music orchestras, and I see an excellent performance, at the beginning, in the middle and at the end. This is not the product of chance, but of constant and disciplined training. There are so many things in life that we are amazed to contemplate, and we say how could it be possible. The answer is the same repeatedly.

DEDICATION

The Lord has executors of his wrath...

Isa 13:3 I have commissioned my consecrated hosts; yes, I have called my heroes to execute my wrath, those who proudly rejoice to do my work.

And these are duly prepared and consecrated for that purpose. Because in them, their obedience and fidelity must stand out, to the one who sends them. Be balanced so that the judgment is equally balanced, always considering the benevolence of the one who has sent it.

Now we are executing instruments of his plan of salvation for humanity. Nobody can execute something of God with precision and perfection if he does not sanctify himself.

2Co 7:1 Therefore, beloved, having these promises, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Let's think about this for a moment: we will be a hindrance, against the stalking of the enemy and we will become hostile against him and his work. Therefore, we must be sober and vigilant.

1Pe 5:8 Thirst for a sober spirit, be alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

Execution is perfection and experience

Each of the problems, battles, or sufferings that we face we will know that it is with a purpose. We should not be disappointed when things do not go well. We must cry out and groan until the answer comes from above and all battle is dissipated.

1Pe 5:9 But resist him firm in faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being fulfilled in your brothers throughout the world.

1Pe 5:10 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself perfect, establish, strengthen, and establish you.

To the extent of this process, we too are being trained and will come to be considered fearsome by our adversaries.

We will achieve unimaginable blessings.

Flp. 1: 6 God began the good work in you, and I am sure that he will perfect it until the day that Jesus Christ returns.

We must never back down. Always forward and walking in the Spirit from Glory to Glory

GAL 3:3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now going to end by the flesh?

If Israel has the Kingdom was taken away for not giving the required size. The same cannot happen to us.

Mat 21:43 Therefore I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken from you and will be given to a nation that produces its fruits.

By their fruits you will know them. Facts are worth more than words. If we say that we are, we must be and if we say that we will comply, we must comply.

That's the life of enforcers.

Luk 19:16» The first of them came, and said: "Sir, I did business with the money, and I earned ten times more than what you gave me."

The one who knows how to execute becomes a winner, in all areas of life, even more so in the path of holiness.

Luk 19:17 The king said to him: "Excellent! You are a good employee. Since you took good care of the little, I gave you, I am appointing you governor of ten cities."

Winners always receive a prize and always end with joy.

Luk 19:18» The second employee came and said: "Sir, I did business with the money, and I earned five times what you gave me."

Luk 19:19 The king said to him, "You will be governor of five cities."

In a Race there will be people who lose, due to their negligence, their short or poor vision and they will justify themselves by blaming others, there are even those who abusively blame God for their problems.

Luk 19:20» Then another employee came and said: "Sir, I know that you are a very demanding man, who asks for the impossible. That's why I was scared, so I wrapped the money in a handkerchief and put it away. Here I give it all back."

If there are no fruits, the person is cut off. God help us to bear fruit worthy of Him.

Mat 3:10 And the ax is already laid to the root of the trees; therefore, every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

Many with power abuse others, Jesus never did that, his life and his power were subject to the Father. We have authorities that we must obey. And value ourselves as children of God and give a good testimony of his love towards the people who are under our authority. Let's think a lot about the Centurion, he understood authority because he himself lived it and executed it without abusing it.

Luk 3:13 Then he said to them, do not demand more than what you have been commanded.

A Parable a Commission

Sowing and harvesting are linked, and one is a consequence of the other. However, the harvest is precisely the beginning of a new sowing. If we choose our first fruits well.

Launching the seed of God is a spiritual act that requires the highest quality (holiness) to give the desired impact.

We cannot suffer from doublemindedness, and neither be looking back. The book of Joel speaks that the plowshares will become swords

This prophecy is linked to the moment in which we come to understand the word and that it has been deepened in our life, which is becoming a powerful sword. A weapon to fight any battle of spiritual type.

Luk 9:62 But Jesus said to him, No one, who after putting his hand to the plow and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

When we analyze the commission of the 70, we realize that it sends them without a bag, and this means that we must trust God to do their work.

Luk 10:1 After this, the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them two by two ahead of Him, to every city and place where He would go.

AT THIS POINT LET US CARRY OUT AN ACTIVITY CALLED THE COMMISSION OF THE 70

Luk 10:2 And he said to them, the harvest is great, but the laborers are few; Pray therefore the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest.

Let's begin to pray that they send workers and that they consider us worthy of such a privilege.

LET'S READ THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER

- 1. Mat 13: the sower went out to sow.
- 2. Mat 13:4 and as he sowed, some of the seed fell by the wayside, and the birds came and ate it up.
- 3. Mat 13:5 Another part fell on stony places where it did not have much soil; and immediately it sprouted because it had no depth of earth.
- 4. Mat 13:6 but when the sun rose, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered.
- 5. Mat 13:7 Another part fell among thorns; and the thorns grew and choked her.
- 6. Mat 13:8 And another part fell on good ground and bore* fruit, some seeds a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty.
- 7. Mat 13:9 He who has ears, let him hear.

Let's place our gaze on those that give 30 x 1 these have 70% barren, without fruit.

How will we make them begin to work in the barren part and bear good fruit? Let us form a suitable spiritual atmosphere. We are that land that has received the seed of life. We need three essential elements for it to bear fruit and reach 100 for one.

WATER



DEU 11:14 He will give your land rain in its season, the early rain, and the latter rain, so that you may gather your grain, your new wine, and your oil.



JOH 20:22 After saying this, he breathed on them and said to them, Receive the Holy Spirit.

FIRE



ACT 2:3 And tongues of fire appeared to them, dividing, and resting on each one of them.

The number 30 represents divine perfection because it comes out of the 3x10 trinity and totality, for this reason the priests began their ministry at the age of 30, just as Jesus began. 30 means maturity.

30 cubits half high the ark

30 cubits high the palm tree

Priests were 30 years old when they began their ministry.

A few years ago, the Lord showed me that this barren 70% was the land that the mature minister was going to conquer.

I think we have reached that stage. Now in another dimension of understanding, we are about to conquer the barren 70%.

Luc. 3:23 And when he began his ministry, Jesus himself was about thirty years old.

We can also apply its meaning to pleasure, "You are my beloved Son, I have been pleased with you", had pleased the Father to an extreme degree, that He testifies publicly. In the bible 70 means totality of life. If you multiply 30X10 = 300, this expresses the fullness of pleasure.

"Enoch walked with God three hundred years... And Enoch walked with God, and he disappeared...

1. Start: Gen 10:1 to 32 Shem, Ham and Japheth, a total of 70, begin to populate the earth after the flood.

Let us place our gaze not on destruction but on the hope of salvation that God proposes. God's mandate to Noah led to the beginning of populating the earth with a genealogy of 70 souls. When we start, let's not look at everything bad that the person has, but let's work from hope against hope.

2. TRAINING: Gen 46:27 And the sons of Joseph, which were born to him in Egypt, were two: all the persons of the house of Jacob that came into Egypt were seventy.

EXO 1:5 All the people who descended from Jacob were seventy souls. But Joseph was already in Egypt.

Even when they are in the world, let us show the land of Gosem, knowing that wonders and protection will be present. Although they are in the world, they are no longer of this world. It would be the motto to use.

3. REPRODUCTION: Deu 10:22 When your fathers went down to Egypt there were seventy people, and now the LORD your God has made you as numerous as the stars in the sky.

With seventy we will start a revival that will upset the land that God gave us as an inheritance.

4. ORDERING: EXO 24:9 ¶ And Moses went up with Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel.

We must obey the authorities and follow the guidelines to be successful.

5. CONGREGATION: NUM 11:24 Then he gathered seventy men from the elders of the town and placed them around the tent.

Never stop meeting together as some have out of habit. Those of us committed to this task must strive to seek to be rooted. Because apart from me you can do nothing, says the Lord. The Word explains about our meeting with Him.

Therefore, everyone who is not used to congregating, how is he going to gather around Christ?

6. REST: JER 29:10 For thus says the Lord: "When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will visit you and fulfill my good word to bring you back to this place.

Although our task is arduous, let us never forget to rest and regain strength. Otherwise, we would not give results with joy. Jethro told Moses choose men who can do your work and have your spirit.

When we do hard work, we impart our spirit to those who follow us and therefore they reproduce what they have learned. And they can in turn pass it on to others.

7. ACTIVATION: LUC 10:17 The seventy returned with joy, saying: Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name.

Activate yourself in this great commission, but do not forget your salvation, take care of it, and always think that your name is in the book of life. And may the Lord have mercy and take us for worthy to be registered and never be erased.

PSA 69:28 May they be blotted out of the book of life, and not be inscribed with the righteous.

How many souls every three months	
How many souls in a year?	
How many souls in 5 years?	

Every pastor will lead you to achieve the character of Christ. He himself is on that path and that is why Paul said: imitate me in what I imitate Christ. Your pastor will be your guide on this path, and he will prepare you with advice and directions so that you can achieve it.

When you have no strength or are discouraged, he will give you a word and you will recover your spiritual vitality. He will correct your mistakes and you will gain maturity and if he recognizes God's call on your life, he will send you.

- 1. to announce his word
- 2. To manage your gifts
- 3. to restore souls
- 4. to reconcile the children
- 5. Be an example by bearing witness to Christ in your life
- 6. To have an intimate relationship with the Lord
- 7. For others to enjoy the benefits of eternal life.

When performing this task

The fruitful ones manifest
They become soul winners
Everyone becomes of the same mind Shepherding is strengthened.

I hope you bear fruit 100-fold, that you reach souls and finish your race with joy.
